

# DEAD STOCK REPORT

## PROBLEM

As an inventory manager, Eli is challenged with both ensuring you have the right product on the ground when the customer wants it as well as having room for the products that are moving in your inventory. 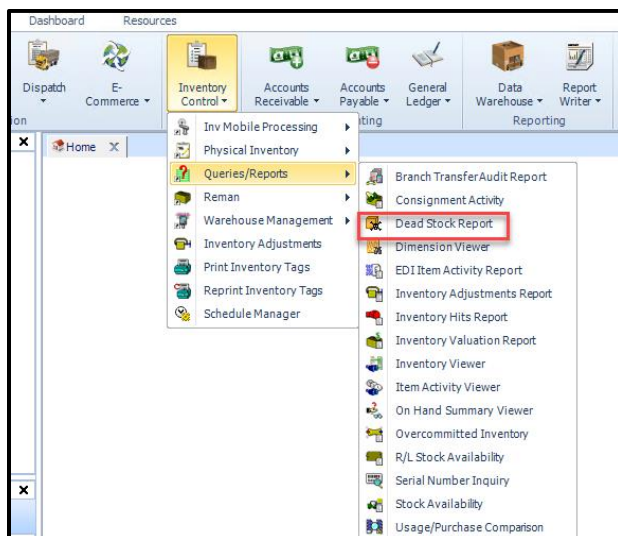
## FAQ's:

### Question:

Where is the Dead Stock Report located, how is it run and what information does it include?

### Answer:

The report is located under Inventory Control > Queries/Reports > Dead Stock Report



### Question:

Are there any items that cannot be included on the Dead Stock?

### Answer:

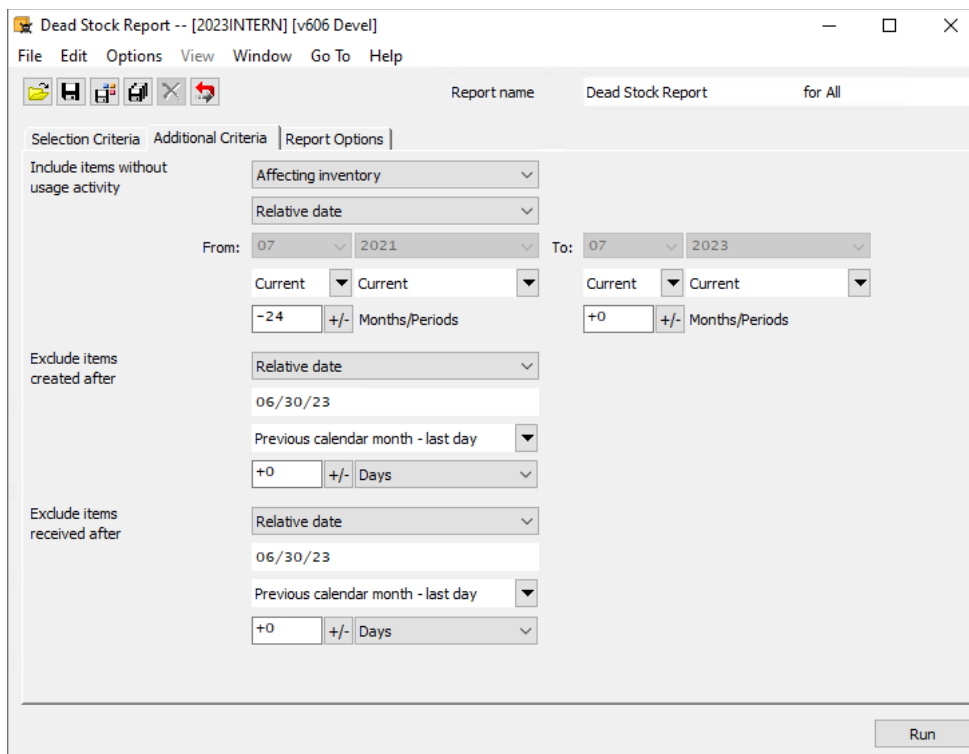
You are unable to run the Dead Stock report if Subtotal dimension type items by dimension, include reorder information, or Combine alternate items grouped for purchasing are set as criteria for the report.

### Question:

When is an item considered no longer "dead" on this report?

### Answer:

Any activity based on the **Activity to Include** on the **Selection Criteria** tab, within the timeframes outlined on the **Additional Criteria** tab will exclude the item from the report. It is recommended to only include activity that affects inventory and only usage that affects the reorder calculations in the report.



### Question:

Beyond the Dead Stock Report- what other information should be reviewed in order to determine if material is truly dead stock?
